

Greensburg. Welcome Home offers 30-60 days of emergency shelter and provides temporary respite for homeless families and single women. Located in downtown Greensburg, Welcome Home can accommodate four families and ten single women at any time. In addition to providing basic needs, Welcome Home also offers life skills classes from other community providers on various topics like cooking skills, budgeting and home management. The shelter is staffed 24 hours a day, and offer case management Monday through Friday. In January of 2016, Welcome Home partnered with the United Way of Westmoreland County and the Union Mission of Latrobe to provide Cold Weather Shelter to individuals displaced in cold weather in Westmoreland County when the weather drops below 25 degrees.
