


ONGOING FUNDRAISERS: Below is a list of the ongoing fundraisers here at FUMC:

- **Pop Can Tabs:** To get service dogs for disabled children and veterans. There will be lots of picnics, graduation parties, etc this summer! If you know of someone having an event, ask them to keep their tabs! It takes 24,000 tabs for one service dog.
- **Clean Closets for Campers:** Our blue donation bins are situated in our church parking lot. The truck from the conference center will come every 15 days and empty these bins. Please continue to clean out and donate any clothing, bedding, towels, shoes, purses, belts and hats to this worthy cause. After donations are weighed and sorted, a check will be sent to our church to replenish our campership fund.
