Do Not Judge Another

¹Welcome those who are weak in faith, but not for the purpose of quarreling over opinions. ²Some believe in eating anything, while the weak eat only vegetables. ³Those who eat must not despise those who abstain, and those who abstain must not pass judgment on those who eat; for God has welcomed them. ⁴Who are you to pass judgment on servants of another? It is before their own lord that they stand or fall. And they will be upheld, for the Lord is able to make them stand.

⁵Some judge one day to be better than another, while others judge all days to be alike. Let all be fully convinced in their own minds. ⁶Those who observe the day, observe it in honor of the Lord. ²³“For this reason the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his slaves. ²⁴When he began the reckoning, one who owed him ten thousand talents was brought to him; ²⁵and, as he could not pay, his lord ordered him to be sold, together with his wife and children and all his possessions, and payment to be made. ²⁶So the slave fell on his knees before him, saying, ‘Have patience with me, and I will pay you everything.’ ²⁷And out of pity for him, the lord of that slave released him and forgave him the debt. ²⁸But that same slave, as he went out, came upon one of his fellow slaves who owed him a hundred denarii; and seizing him by the throat, he said, ‘Pay what you owe.’ ²⁹Then his fellow slave fell down and pleaded with him, ‘Have patience with me, and I will pay you.’ ³⁰But he refused; then he went and threw him into prison until he would pay the debt. ³¹When his fellow slaves saw what had happened, they were greatly distressed, and they went and reported to their lord all that had taken place. ³²Then his lord summoned him and said to him, ‘You wicked slave! I forgave you all that debt because you pleaded with me. ³³Should you not have had mercy on your fellow slave, as I had mercy on you? ³⁴And in anger his lord handed him over to be tortured until he would pay his entire debt. ³⁵So my heavenly Father will also do to every one of you, if you do not forgive your brother or sister from your heart.”

FROM THE FINANCE COMMITTEE:

To Our Church Family,

As you know, since the COVID-19 Pandemic, we have been blest to be able to watch our church services by streaming online through Zoom, Facebook, and YouTube, as well as with the Drive-In services from our parking lot. Initially, in order to provide these church services, a few members had graciously donated the use of their personal equipment to get started. Since this temporary problem continues, and no one knows when we will be able to worship inside, we need to obtain our own streaming and broadcasting equipment. (Costing \$7,000)

Additionally, there has been another financial stress on our budget. It is that of an aging boiler and heating system. With the yearly inspection, it was discovered our boiler required some much-needed repairs. (Costing \$8,000)

The Church Council, the Finance Committee, and the Trustees have approved the funds to provide for the above mentioned, non-budgeted expenses. However, in doing so it has put a strain on our already tight budget.

We humbly come to you for an additional gifting request above your regular giving. We appreciate your continued financial support through this unprecedented time. We would appreciate any and all designated donations for these two causes.
